The Presque Isle Rotary Club has raised millions of dollars for community projects over several decades, projects ranging from healthcare and economic development to local parks and youth sports, and a whole lot in between. For many years, members of the Presque Isle Rotary Club have discussed opportunities to build a lasting, permanent structure in Presque Isle as a symbol of our commitment to building and bettering our greater community. The amphitheater will be located in downtown Presque Isle, across from the Sargent Community Center and nestled between the Riverside Playground and Mary's Mile walking path. It will be surrounded by grassy, level ground which will provide ample seating for community gatherings and is located near a small parking lot that could easily be designated to allow handicap accessible parking and access to events.

Why an Amphitheater?

The amphitheater will allow a permanent location for existing performing arts and opportunities to host new cultural events. This new building can be used to hold events like: Summer Concert Series, theater productions, movie nights, award ceremonies, and countless other initiatives. We are hopeful this project will continue the positive momentum already happening in the community, promoting growth and attracting new businesses and people from outside the region.
